Course Details - What will the course consist of and how will it be delivered?

All students will study OCR English Language GCSE (J351). There is one tier of entry.

The English Language GCSE is designed to help learners explore communication, culture and creativity, to develop independent and critical thinking and to engage our language and literary heritage.



At GCSE, learners will:

- Develop the skills to read fluently and write effectively.
- Be encouraged to engage with a wide variety of high-quality texts both literary and non-fiction, across a range of familiar genres.
- Develop the skills to analyse critically and synthesise and evaluate ideas and information across unseen texts.
- Be given the opportunity to experiment in their writing across a range of contexts and styles.



A variety of teaching and learning methods are used and students will continue to be set according to their academic targets and current attainment.
