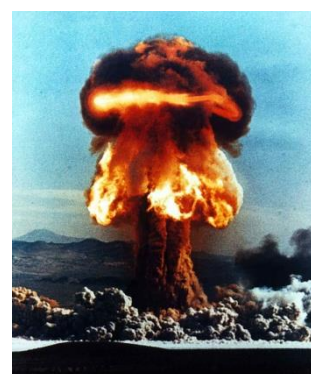
Course Details - What will the course consist of and how will it be delivered?

- British Depth Study: The Norman Conquest 1065-1087
- Thematic Study: Crime and Punishment 1250 to present
- World Depth Study: Living under Nazi rule 1933-1945
- Period Study: The Making of America 1789-1900
- History Around Us: a study of a site in its historical context
