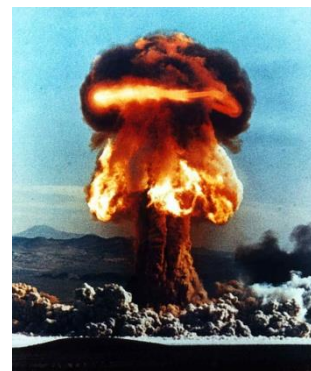

Course Details - What will the course consist of and how will it be delivered?

The GCSE History course consists of four units

- Thematic Study: Crime and Punishment, c1000 – present and Whitechapel, c1870 – c1900 crime policing and the inner city.
- Anglo-Saxon and Norman England, c1060-1088
- Superpower relations and the cold war, 1941-1991
- Weimar and Nazi Germany, 1918 – 1939.
